ABOUT ATSSS:-

ATSSS is a non-profitable, Non-Governmental Secular organization. It has been registered under Government of Tamil Nadu Societies registration act of 1975. It has been working under the able guidance of Mr. K. Selvaraj, President across four blocks of Villupuram District. ATSSS work is seeable, measurable and visible to the beneficiaries, well wishers and donors and the people who stood in our cause.

The annual report summarizes the activities undertaken by ATSSS during the reporting period 2017 - 2018.

1. KGBV Residential School at Thirupalpanthal:-

KGBV Programme under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan is functioning at Thirupalapandal. The program covers 100 drop out girl children in the classes of VI, VII, and VIII standard. But ATSSS cum KGBV renders its facilities and services to the children up to college level. The program involves 5 teachers, one accountant, one physical educator,



one computer instructor, one tailoring trainer, and one office assistant in addition to that three cook and one watchman.

It covers the services regarding the salary of staffs, student stipend, stationery expenses, provision of food, vocational & skill training in the areas of Karate, beauty culture, dancing skill and also monthly medical checkup, water and sanitation are inclusive part of program.

PROVISION OF FOOD

The program provides healthy and hygienic food to the students. There is perfect healthy menu chart. It provides both veg and non veg menu



according to the interest of the student. It provides weekly once chicken and mutton. It also provides fruits, healthy diet in the menu chart. Every day morning drink, morning breakfast, lunch, evening snacks, dinner and night drink was provided.

COMFORTABLE LIVING:

The program provides bedding materials like bed spread, bed sheet, pillow, pillow cover, bucket, mug, towel, innerwear to each and everyone. It also provides assistance to comfortable living in the hostel



by providing cosmetic items like bath soap, washing soap, shampoo, oil, paste, brush, powder and so on. The students are happily and comfortably living in the hostel by using the benefits provided by the program.



Educational assistance:



The program provides all kinds of educational assistance to the students. It provides textbook, notebook and uniform which were provided to all the students. Other than these the program provides stationary items like notebooks, pencil, pen, sharpener, Eraser and so on every month.

The students were provided with 3 sets of uniforms like Karate uniform, Sports uniform and Guide uniform and they were taught with karate, Guide and sports.

Formal education was provided with qualified and talented teachers for every subject. They are teaching not only in the school hours but also they are assisting student in the evening. Library was there with above 500 books for valuable education.

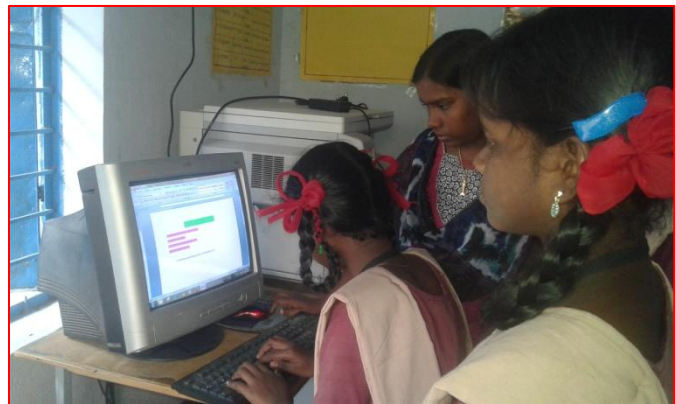


It also provides Rs.100 as RD postal account for their future educational assistance.

COMPUTER, SPORTS, TAILORING, KARATE AND BEAUTY EDUCATION:

The students are provided with computer, sports, tailoring, craftwork, karate and beauty culture education other than formal education.

Computer education was provided weekly 3 classes to all the students. In this class the basic programs are taught to work like paint, MS Word, MS excel, MS PowerPoint and so on. Students taught with both theoretical and practical classes. They were allowed to work in computer and excel their knowledge in computer.



Physical education was taught weekly 3 classes and Saturday also was taken to strengthen the physical body of the students. They were taught all kinds of games, and they were trained to play in school level. They were also taught yoga. Students are eagerly learning the physical education.



Tailoring and craftwork and handwork were taught to the students. Stitching chudi,



blouse, skirt and so on are taught. Students were also taught with craftwork and handwork like basket weaving, earring making, golden tree, flower making, painting and so on are taught.

Karate was taught to the students. In order to protect themselves students are taught with Karate. They also taught



Beauty course. To make them beautiful students are taught with beauty culture also.



TRAINING TO STUDENTS:



The students are provided with various training in order to make them a perfect one. Every month, they are provided with different training to provide different exposure. Vermin compost training, lamination training, first aid training, online bus and train ticket booking training, spiral training, life skill training are provided to make them learn all the things available to them.



MEDICAL CAMP: Every month students are provided with medical assistance. The students are checked and diagnosed and then treated with proper medicines. If there is no need to go to hospital, reference letter was provided by the doctor to the concerned GH. Health card was maintained to the students.

Successful mainstream; The students who are studying 8th standard and mainstreamed to 9th standard. In the same way this year 38 students are successfully completed their 8th standard with good percentage of marks and mainstreamed in



RMSA hostel and schools in order to avoid them dropped out from any class.

2. KGBV Residential School-II at Koothanur

KGBV Residential school-II has been at Koothanur Village, Ulundurpet Block, Villupuram District. There are 50 drop out girl children are



accommodated in the centre. They are provided with food, stipend, stationery expenses, staff salary for 5 teachers, 1 accountant, 1 physical education, 1 computer, 1 tailoring teacher and one non-teaching staff, further 2

cooks and one watchmen.

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3. SHG Program

The Women self Help Group Program comes under the support of ICICI Bank, Chennai intervention.

Target Area - Villupuram District, 1800 Women Self Help Group are operating across Villupuram District. The Number is 27000 Women members a total of 250 WSHGs are operating in Cuddalore District. The total of 3750 women members in 150 WSHGs are operating in Thiruvannamalai District.

In the year 2017, the members of WSHGs are provided with Rs.12,37,15,800/- (crores) through ICICI bank covering 5126 members and in the 2018, the members of WSHGs are provided with Rs. 6,18,70,300/- (crores) through ICICI bank covering 2558members. Totally till now Rs. 59,74,01,340/- was provided as a loan to the 27176 members are benefitted through this loan.
