About ATSSS:-

ATSSS is a non-profitable, Non-Governmental Secular organisation. It has been registered under Government of Tamil Nadu Societies registration act of 1975. It has been working under the able guidence of Mr. Selvaraj, President across four blocks of Villupuram District. ATSSS work is seeable, measurable and visible to the beneficiaries, well wishers and donors and the people who stood in our cause.

The annual report summarise the activities undertaken by ATSSS during the reporting period 2016 - 2017.

1) Residential special Training Centre:-

RSTC Program runs at No.18 Karthikeyan Nagar, Asanur Main Road, Tirukoilur under SSA, Villupuram. It has been running since 2005, the inmates of school are 100 dropout children. The program involves children's maintenance, Electricity Bill, Water and sanitation and Rent, fuel charge and miscellaneous.

2) KGBV Residential School at Thirupalpanthal:-

KGBV Programme under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan is functioning at Thirupalapandal. The program covers 100 drop out girl children in the classes of VI, VII, and VIII standard. But ATSSS cum KGBV renders its facilities and services to the children up to college level. The program involves 5 teachers, one accountant, one physical educator, one computer instructor, one tailoring trainer, and one office assistant in addition to that three cook and one watchman. It covers the services regarding the salary of staffs, student stipend, stationery expenses, provision of food, vocational & skill training in the areas of Karate, beauty culture, dancing skill and also monthly health medical check up, water and sanitation are inclusive part of program.

The program provides medical assistance to the children under the fund of Medical contingency. Preparatory camp was conducted in order to get admission of the dropout children who are struggling to get proper education. The program provides facilities to fulfil the needs of the children in the aspects food, cosmetics, stationary, medical, formal education, skill education, and various kind of vocational and valuable education.

The program operates RD postal account of Rs.100 for their future educational assistance. The School has celebrated all the important functions and annual days. The School regularly conducts PTA meeting and Mother Association. This year 35 students of VIII standard successfully moving to IX Standard. The school was proved with 100 percent result.

3) KGBV Residential School-II

KGBV Residential school-II has been at Koothanoor Village, Ulundurpet Block, Villupuram District. There are 50 drop out girl children are accommodated in the centre. They are provided with food, stipend, stationery expenses, staff salary for 5 teachers, 1 accountant, 1 physical education, 1 computer, 1 tailoring teacher and one non-teaching staff, further 2 cooks and one watchmen. They are also provided with vocational skill like Karate, dancing, Games and sports, and medical contingency.

The program provides medical assistance to the children under the fund of Medical contingency. Preparatory camp was conducted in order to get admission of the dropout children who are struggling to get proper education. The program provides facilities to fulfil the needs of the children in the aspects food, cosmetics, stationary, medical, formal education, skill education, and various kind of vocational and valuable education.

The program operates RD postal account of Rs.100 for their future educational assistance. The School has celebrated all the important functions and annual day. The School regularly conducts PTA meeting and Mother Association. The school was proved with 100 percent result.

4) Old Age Home & Children Home

Old age home & Children Home is operating at No.18 Karthikeyan Nagar, Asanur Main Road, Tirukoilur, Villupuram District. An inmate of old age home is 25 while inmates of children home is 25. They are provided Food and Boarding support, salary for 9 caretakers for old age

home while 7 caretakers for children home. Counsellor, Doctor, Nurse, Helper, Cook and Watchmen are the personnel of old age home. Project Co-ordinator Cum Counsellor-1, Teachers-2, Doctors-1, Nurse-1, Caretaker-1, Worker-1, Watchmen-1 are managing the program for success conduct. The programs of old age and children home is visible, measurable and our auditing, accounting records are open to the perusal of SSA, Villupuram District, State project Director and those who wish to see and verify it.

5) SHG Loan Program

The Women self Help Group Program comes under the support of ICICI Bank, Chennai intervention.

Target Area - Villupuram District, 1800 Women Self Help Group are operating across Villupuram District. The Number is 27000 Women members a total of 250 WSHGs are operating in Cuddalore District. The total of 3750 women members in 150 WSHGs are operating in Thiruvannamalai District.

Under Villupuram District WSHG Intervention

A tune of 40 crores (Forty Crores) has been distributed to Women Self Help Groups by ICICI Bank for self Development Business which will remove them from poverty and financial harassment.

Cuddalore District

A total of seven Crores (7 Crores) has been distributed to 150 Women Self Help Groups to start a self development business initiative.

Thiruvannamalai District

A tune of 8 Crores (8 Crores) is sanctioned and distributed to 250 women self help Groups the money is for starting self development business initiatives.
